THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINN. – The Thief River Falls Chamber of Commerce announced today that the 2nd Annual Thief River Falls Day at the Capitol will be held in St. Paul on Tuesday, March 13. The one-day trip via Wi-Fi equipped motor coach allows community leaders and residents to meet and engage state legislators on the future growth of Thief River Falls.
