Marketing Your Website workshop to be held on October 27

THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINN. – The Thief River Falls Chamber of Commerce announced today that a workshop entitled *Marketing Your Website* will be held at the Chamber office (2017 Highway 59 SE) on Thursday, October 27, from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. The workshop will be presented by Art Nash, an economist and educator with University of Minnesota Extension.

This hands-on workshop will help businesses and organizations understand how customers find websites. It will also explore how social media, online advertising, blogs, and e-newsletters can increase website traffic.
